THE YEAR 7 ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT CLASS PROGRAM

Lambton High School provides opportunities for every student to attain their personal best and has programs to facilitate this objective. As well as the comprehensive mainstream classes, Lambton High School operates an Academic Enrichment stream in each of the Years 7-10.

The e³ class: engage, enrich and extend, is designed to cater for Year 7 students who live in our local school zone, who perform at a high academic level and are highly motivated and keen to extend themselves in their learning. It is a school-based initiative that in some schools might be labelled as a "Gifted and Talented" class.

Parents are invited to apply for a place for their student in the e³ class. Along with the application form, parents are invited to submit a portfolio of evidence supporting the application. This might include past school reports, NAPLAN results, results in academic competitions such as ICAS, offers of selective class placement and/or information indicating student interests and achievements.

Students will also be required to complete a placement test set by the University of NSW: The International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) test.

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

In the Academic Enrichment classes students study the core curriculum in the relevant subjects in common with their year cohort; however, their curriculum is compacted and qualitatively differentiated to allow more time for enrichment, extension, problem solving and critical thinking skills. Extension involves the provision of more advanced work within the existing subject frameworks.



The cost of the test is \$22. This amount must be paid at the time of application at the Lambton High School Office so we can order a test for your student. Application forms must be submitted by **Thursday 1 April 2021**.

The e3 test will be held at Lambton High from 9.40am to 11.40am on **20 May 2021**. Students should be at Lambton High by 9.15am. Parents may collect their student at 11.55am from the Multi-Purpose Centre.

A second test date is set on **21 May 2021** as above. **(Please note students are not required at both testing dates)**

If you intend on applying for placement, please notify your student's Primary School of the details provided.

It is important to note that only students who are locally zoned to Lambton High School as Year 7 2022 enrolments will be offered the opportunity to submit applications for consideration in placement to the e3 class. This is in line with the department's enrolment policy. Further information can be found via:

Students in this class will be required to demonstrate a high level of commitment to their studies and continually strive to achieve their personal best. Each semester student placement will be reviewed on the following considerations:

- Academic performance
- Commitment to learning
- Exemplary student behaviour

Selection Criteria

In addition to our general enrolment criteria:

- A strong academic record and a record of sound behaviour and attendance.
- Ranking in the University of NSW: The International Competitions and Assessment for Schools (ICAS) test.
