INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

YEAR 7 CAPA ENRICHMENT CLASS PROGRAM

The Creating and Performing Arts (CAPA) enrichment class encompasses the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) syllabus content for Drama, Music and Visual Arts. The course of study offers Year 7 students who live in our local school zone a combined creative arts experience. After completing one year in the program students can then apply for an extension of this program for potential entry into acceleration programs.

CAPA students will have the opportunity to explore their chosen art form in a wide variety of classroom experiences and extra-curricular activities that run within the school community. Public performance, mentoring and tuition from specialist teachers is available to all.

The point of difference around this program is that the students who are accepted into the program are identified as being talented and/or gifted in the Creative Arts and their classwork, programming and assessment in all subject areas will encompass their background, skills and talents. Specific teachers in all the KLAs will be selected to teach this class and be able to cater to their preferred learning styles across the mandatory subjects.

Acceleration Programs

Acceleration students begin studying Stage 5/6 courses ahead of their cohort. These students are exceptional students who attain the NESA curriculum outcomes in less time than other students.

It is an annual school-based decision as to whether these programs proceed. Students are accepted on the basis of their written application, academic performance, behaviour, audition, interview and their involvement extrain curricular and/or out-ofschool interests and abilities.



It is intended, as part of the learning philosophy around this program, that students will participate in the extra-curricular activities offered by the school:

- School Concert Band
- Vocal Ensemble
- Enrichment Art Workshops
- Excursions
- Drama Workshops
- Dance Programs
- Festivals; Star Struck Drama/Choir/Dance, Drama Festival, Music Festival, Music: Count Us In & Choral Works

A substantial number of student applications are received annually for the CAPA class. The specific criteria for ranking students to be offered places in this class include:

- Proven talent, involvement/experience and expertise in the creative and/or performing arts, through participation in auditions and providing necessary evidence.
- A strong academic record and a record of sound behaviour and attendance.
- Demonstrated engagement in extra-curricular activities, showcasing the strength of a holistic student at a comprehensive high school.

It is important to note that only students who are locally zoned to Lambton High School as Year 7 2025 enrolments will be offered the opportunity to submit applications for consideration in placement for the CAPA class. APPLICATION & AUDITION INFORMATION

Students, along with parents/carers, are required to complete the following online application form via the links provided:

 - A Google account (e.g. @gmail.com or student email used for Google Classroom) will be required to access the form.
 - Applications Close: Wednesday 10 April 2024
- General Audition Information
 - Students may audition across multiple disciplines, yet will need to complete individual auditions and/or portfolio submissions in each area.
 - Information about the audition procedure, including time and date, will be forwarded to you via email in Term 2 Week 2.
 - Supporting documentation (uploaded in your application form) addressing the selection criteria will be assessed by the school, in addition to the skills demonstrated in the audition process. The examiner's decision is final. No feedback will be provided regarding the applicant's audition assessment.

• Drama Audition Requirements

- 1. Prepare a 1-2 minute scripted monologue of student's own choosing. No poetry or self-written scripts.
- 2. Take part in a one-hour Drama Improvisation Workshop.
- 3. Wear comfortable clothing that you can easily move in.

• Music Audition Requirements

- 1. Prepare a piece of music no longer than 4 minutes that demonstrates both your technical ability and expression.
- 2. Bring your instrument to the audition.
- 3. A piano, drum kit and amplifiers are available for use if you wish.
- 4. A laptop computer is available if required for backing track playback.

• Visual Arts Audition Requirements

- 1. Students need to prepare a portfolio of their artmaking. This can be compiled from work that they have completed at home, school or in any extra-curricular activity that they participate in. This portfolio will be kept by the school until later in Term 2 2023.
- 2. Students will participate in a 1.5-hour Visual Arts Workshop where they will be asked to complete a series of tasks that are designed to identify their skills and strengths.
