On behalf of the Lambton HS, I would like to invite you to attend a presentation to receive important information to support your student's transition to high school in 2026.

  - **Both evenings are the same presentation (conducted over alternate dates to allow for attendance).**

Our aim is to provide valuable information about the transition program, to discuss aspects of high school life and provide details of the Year 7 curriculum. At this meeting we will highlight the many successful school-based programs conducted in the domains of academia, welfare, learning support, environmental education, student leadership, high potential and gifted education, sport and the creative and performing arts. At Lambton HS we believe in encouraging all students to take every opportunity to improve and widen their educational experience.

Key programs discussed on the evening will include:

- **Year 7 e<sup>3</sup> Class (engage, enrich and extend):** Catering for students who perform at a high academic level, are highly motivated and wish to extend themselves in their learning. Students wanting to gain a placement in this class are required to complete an online application, pay an application fee and undertake a placement test.
- **Year 7 CAPA Class:** Encompasses Drama, Music and Visual Arts syllabus content. The course offers Year 7 students a combined creative arts experience across all mandatory curriculum areas. Students are required to submit an online application and undertake a scheduled audition.

  - Applications for both the Year 7 e<sup>3</sup> and CAPA classes close on **Wednesday 9 April 2025.**

It is important to note that only students who are locally-zoned to Lambton HS as Year 7 2026 will have their enrolment applications processed and approved. Due to the current level of enrolments, and compliance with the Department of Education's enrolment policy, the school is not currently accepting any out of area enrolments.
